This scholarship is a gift to benefit education in memory of Dominic Saverino. Dominic graduated from Glenbard North High School in 1992 where he participated in football and wrestling. Dominic had a wonderful sense of humor and was always there to lend a helping hand to his family, neighbors, and even strangers, which gained him much love and respect by many. He was dedicated to serving his community, neighbors, and those in need, devoting his time and talents to various charitable organizations. As an example, Dominic was a member of the Chicago Italian American Charitable Organization which had an annual Thanksgiving Food Drive called "Baskets of Love". Their first food drive over 15 years ago provided 25 "Baskets of Love" to families in need. Dominic eventually became the President for CIACO, and because this event was very special to him, his concentrated effort increased donations to over 300 baskets. This took a tremendous amount of donations and teamwork from many volunteers, but has continued to flourish, now donating over nearly 600 "Basket of Love" annually to families in need. We are dedicated to continuing his servant leadership legacy.
